LEADING WITH SUCCESS

Session Title	Description
Best Practices to Lead with Success	This session prepares educators to successfully implement Imagine Galileo K–12 Assessment and explores how to craft assessment plans and create a comprehensive assessment system with a phased approach.
Establishing a Data Culture	Support leaders in establishing a culture of data-driven instruction. Educators will explore how Imagine Galileo report data and reliable assessment results can be used to inform action plans for district- and school-wide instruction, intervention, and enrichment initiatives.
Engaging Families and the Community with Imagine Galileo	Educators will create a plan for communicating with various stakeholders about test results. Strategies will be developed for understanding and appropriately communicating Imagine Galileo test results.
Maximizing Mid and End of Year Benchmark Data	In this session, educators will analyze comparative data used to evaluate and refine the action plans created at the beginning of the year. Imagine Galileo experts cover the support process, the application of resources, and providing additional professional development. <i>(Suggestion: Schedule after your Middle-of-Year Benchmark Imagine Galileo ELA Benchmark Assessment.)</i>
Leading PLCs with Imagine Galileo Assessment Data	Explore how Imagine Galileo can be used in a professional learning community (PLC) cycle that consists of analyzing data, setting goals, implementing strategies, monitoring success, and reprioritizing goals.

Session Title	Description
Supporting Differentiation of Instruction & Interventions	This session covers the differentiation of instruction and implementation of interventions across district and school sites. Educators will apply a needs analysis to determine the best groupings to maximize learning for all students.
Including Formative Assessment in Your Data Story	This workshop assists educators in identifying and discussing their formative assessment needs and how to craft a plan that can be used to manage school- and district-wide instruction, intervention, and enrichment initiatives.

Session Title	Description
Getting Started with Imagine Galileo	This session covers student tools and prepares educators to support and monitor online testing using the key features within the Imagine Galileo Dashboard. Educators will learn how to monitor key data points and the steps to take to ensure a successful start.
Taking Action with Initial Benchmark Data	Equip educators with a foundational understanding of Imagine Galileo's report suite. The session focuses on interpreting student performance and standards mastery data. <i>(Recommended two weeks after the administration of the benchmark when educators can analyze their own student data.)</i>
Engaging Families with Imagine Galileo	This session helps teachers prepare for parent-teacher conferences, highlighting which reports and future student goals to share with parents. Teachers are also introduced to the Imagine Galileo Student/Parent Center, a powerful resource for increasing family engagement. <i>(Prerequisite: Taking Action with Initial Benchmark Data.)</i>
Maximizing Mid-Year Benchmark Data	This session dives deeper into Imagine Galileo Benchmark assessment data and reports as educators identify standards on which to focus instruction and interventions. <i>(Prerequisite: Taking Action with Initial Benchmark Data.)</i>

Session Title	Description
Imagine Galileo Intervention Tools to Promote Student Learning	In this session, participants learn how Imagine Galileo can help them use assessment data to implement interventions. Educators will explore the best way to group students, including by standards mastery, risk level, or growth.
Progress Monitoring with Imagine Galileo Formative Assessments	Explore how Imagine Galileo's pre-made and flexible formatives can assist in identifying students learning accomplishments and needs. Teachers can use formative assessments on their own or collaborate with team members to create a repository of formative assessments.
